Summer always drew Wink and his family to the Ocean City Beach. As a child, Wink spent his summers on the beach, developing an appreciation for the ocean, that he passed on to his own children. He was the first one on the beach with a book in hand.

Wink's friendships ran deep and wide, to this day his Haverford High School "committee members" remained close, gathering annually for Turkey Bowl for over 50 years. Wink

looked forward this event every year.

Wink will always be remembered for his quiet ways and his love for the “little things in life.”
