



A. Barton Lewis

August 4, 1925 - May 5, 2008

A. Barton Lewis, Mortgage Banker, 82, died peacefully on Monday May 5, 2008.

Mr. Lewis' education included the degree of Bachelor of Civil Engineering from the Univ. of Delaware and an MBA from Wharton School of the Univ. of Penna.

Mr. Lewis' civic activities included: Chairman, U.S. Committee for Oceans and the Philadelphia Chapter of American Technion Society, Board of the American Red Cross, SEPA Chapter, Board of Trustees, Friends Central School, Council on Ocean Law.

Mr. Lewis began his career as a Jr. Engineer for Design Service Co. He went on to become the Asst. Supervisor of Real Estate in the Mortgage Loan Dept. of Penn Mutual Life Insurance Co and President of Republic Mortgage Co. He established A. Barton Lewis & Co., in 1962 Inc. where he worked until 2003.

He secured financing for major sites in Philadelphia and throughout the United States,

including: Two Penn Center, Public Ledger Office Bldg., 1818 Market St., National

Visitors Center in Washington, DC, formerly Union Station, \$56 million of Nantucket, MA commercial property and harbor facilities.

He held memberships in the Midday Club, The Racquet Club, The Brigantine Yacht

Club and the Corinthian Yacht Club.

Mr. Lewis was active in the Quaker community and he was a member of Radnor

Friends Meeting.

He is survived by his wife, Marjorie Bilk Lewis, and his daughter, Julia Rose Lewis.

A memorial service will be held on Monday May 12, 11am in Radnor Friends Meeting, 610 Conestoga Rd., Ithan (at the intersection of Conestoga & Sproul Rds.)
