January 7, 1926 - February 15, 2021

Adelaide T. Haws (nee Thorogood) of Glenmoore, Pennsylvania passed away peacefully on February 15, 2021 after a short illness. She was 95.

Born in Ardmore, PA on January 7, 1926, she was the daughter of the late Philip C. and Adelina (McClare) Thorogood and sister of the late Dorothy T. Gibbs and the late Philip C. Thorogood, Jr. Adelaide attended Wynnewood Road School and Ardmore Junior High. She was a graduate of Lower Merion High School, Class of 1943. After graduation she worked for the Pennsylvania Railroad in Philadelphia. A lifelong Episcopalian, Adelaide, known to everyone as Addy, was baptised, confirmed and married in St Mary's Church, Ardmore. On September 3, 1949 she married her childhood sweetheart, Harvey L. Haws in St Mary's Church. The couple were blessed with the birth of their first born in 1951, a daughter they named Wendy. The family of three moved to Newtown Square, PA. The family grew to five with the birth of a son in 1953 named Steven and a daughter Kimberly in 1962. A devoted and loving wife and mother, she relished in raising her family. After her youngest daughter began school, she began a part time job with Marple-Newtown School District working in the cafeteria of Marple-Newtown Junior High School where she made lasting friendships with her colleagues. She had a penchant for contests and quizzes on local radio. Her knowledge of facts from a broad range of subjects would pay off as she won many prizes, including trips to Hawaii, Bermuda and Florida. In 2004 after living in Newtown Square for 52 years, Addy and Harvey moved to Glenmoore, PA to enjoy their retirement years.

Addy loved and was loved by her six nieces and their families as well as her cousins, friends, and neighbors.

Addy is survived by Harvey, her husband of 71 years, her children, Wendy Neuhoff of Glenmoore, PA, Steven Haws of Mirfield, England, and Kimberly Robinson and her husband John of West Chester, PA. Her beloved son in law, the late William Neuhoff, died in 2012. Addy is also survived by her grandchildren, Jason Neuhoff and his wife Kara, Cory Neuhoff, John Robinson, III, Matthew Robinson, and her great grandchildren, Lauren Neuhoff and Paige Neuhoff.
