Alan Lee Ball, Sr. of Ardmore PA, died peacefully Friday, January 28, 2011 in Wayne, PA. His 82 years of life were filled with family and friends. Born in Philadelphia on October 13, 1928, Alan obtained his GED after having left West Philadelphia High School in order to work with his father. In the Korean War he served as a telegraph operator in Germany for two years. After time served, he returned to continue working at the Earl J. Ball Agency which later became his own theatrical agency. He was married to Rose Marie Marrollo, his wife of 48 years. He went on to work for Haverford Township School District for almost 20 years. Alan was a 60-year member of the Saint John's Lodge #115. He loved spending time with his family, traveling and visiting with friends and neighbors. He was an avid reader and collector of books.
