



Alice Pusey Holland

Alice Pusey Holland died of cancer on November 26th, three weeks after her 84th birthday. Mrs. Holland grew up in New Jersey and graduated from Oberlin College in 1948. In 1953, she married Heinrich D. Holland, then a young faculty member at Princeton University. Four children, Henry L., Anne L., John P., and Matthew T., were born between 1954 and 1959. Her greatest joy was raising these children and later her four grandchildren. She was a long-time member of the Planning Board and the Library Committee in Rocky Hill, NJ.

In 1972 she and her family moved to Winchester, MA. She became the Advertising Manager of the American Orchid Society while her husband was a professor at Harvard University. She moved to Wynnewood, PA in 2006 with her husband after his retirement to be closer to their children and grandchildren.

She celebrated her 84th birthday happily with her family; but two days later she was stricken by her fatal illness. Her family and friends remember her with love and admiration for her great caring, her devotion to history, her superb skill in sewing and knitting, and her love of travel and orchids.
