



Andrew Converse Warren

December 27, 1927 - December 5, 2012

Andrew C. Warren, 84, of Villanova, died peacefully on Dec. 5, 2012. Raised in Bala Cynwyd, he graduated from the Episcopal Academy in 1946 and the University of Virginia in 1950. He served as a member of the First Troop Philadelphia City Calvary, a National Guard Division of the U.S. Army, stationed in Germany during the Korean War.

Andy was an avid golfer and a former member of the Philadelphia Country Club and the Merion Golf Club. He also loved music, especially playing the piano and singing. He had been a member of the Suburban Squires, a men's a cappella group, and the choir at the Church of the Redeemer in Bryn Mawr. He was an insurance executive and retired in 1990.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Joan D. Warren; their four children, Andrew C. Warren, Jr. (Elizabeth) of Orlando, Florida, Greer T. Warren (Paul Gold) of Tucson, Arizona, Polly W. Coxe (Ted) of Bryn Mawr, and Michael D. Warren (Lisa) of Wayne; and four grandchildren, Michael, Phillip, Genevieve and Elyse.

He was predeceased by his brothers, Hugh I. Warren and James F. Warren, Jr.

His memorial service was held on Dec. 11 at the Church of the Redeemer in

Bryn Mawr.
