Anne Patricia Hart, 63, a fiercely independent woman of faith, succumbed to pancreatic cancer on October 15, 2014 after a ten-month fight. She was the daughter of the late Eileen T. (née O'Neill) and Joseph E. Hart and older sister of the late William Hart. Anne's life was one of ceaseless generosity and love for others. She was rightfully proud of her work and of her lifelong loyalty and reliability as a friend and colleague.

She is survived by her older brother Shawn Joseph Hart, his wife Kari Hart and their two daughters, Katharine and Amanda, sister-in-law Debra Hart and nephews Dylan and Eric Hart. Anne will be deeply missed by her family, friends and coworkers.

She loved to dance.

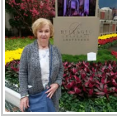
