



## Anne M. Smith

November 22, 1932 - October 1, 2010

Anne M. Smith, of Gladwyne, died peacefully surrounded by her family on Friday, Oct. 1, 2010.

She was the beloved wife of 52 years of Bradford D. Smith, the cherished mother of B. Davison Smith, Jr MD (Annette G.); Leigh Anne Smith (James G.); Susan E. Bies (Robert J.); Douglas L. Smith (Susan H.); Debra S. Anne Myers was born in 1932 in Cleveland, Ohio, the only child of Elizabeth Hickey and C. Leland Myers. As an infant she moved to this area and grew up on Howe Road. Anne graduated from the Lower Merion public schools in 1950 and the University of Pennsylvania School of Education in 1954. Anne and Brad Smith were married upon graduation in June, 1954 and settled in Narberth. Mrs. Smith taught for 2 years at the Penn Valley Elementary School. She and her husband then relocated to Gladwyne where they raised their growing family. Anne spent many happy volunteer years in Lower Merion Schools, Cub Scouts, Brownies, and Girl Scouts.

In 1975 she was elected and served the Lower Merion School District as a school board director for 14 years, 2 as president. For over thirty four years, Anne was employed by two banks in the village of Gladwyne. Mrs. Smith was

a member of the Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church, Daughters of the American Revolution (Cumberland County Chapter), and the Philadelphia Country Club.

Mrs. Smith's professional and community accomplishments paled in comparison to the real focus of her life - the family that she and her husband created, the children and grandchildren they raised and the love they shared with them. She will be greatly missed.
