



Barbara "Bobbie" H. Eckman

October 26, 1921 - September 21, 2014

Barbara Harding (Bobbie) Eckman, 92, of Brookhaven, (formerly of Bryn Mawr) passed away on Sept. 21, 2014 at Paoli Hospital.

Barbara was the loving mother of Alison Eckman Bieser of Houston, Texas, and Stephen Keyler Eckman of Swampscott, Mass., grandmother of Benjamin Eckman Bieser and Peter Wray Eckman and mother-in-law of John Oren Bieser and Margaret MacKay Eckman.

Barbara was born in East Orange, N.J, on October 26, 1921. She graduated from Miss Beard's School and from Southern Seminary Junior College, now Southern Virginia University. A 50-year Bryn Mawr resident, she had many friends and interests and was actively involved in a number of civic, arts-related and charitable organizations as a member, leader or volunteer.

She was a member of Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church, the Junior League of Philadelphia, the Daughters of the American Revolution and Historic New England, among other organizations. She served as president of the Pennsylvania Society of New England Women, as committee chair on the Board of Women Visitors of the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania Medical Center, on the board of historic Strawberry Mansion and as a volunteer at Harriton House in Bryn Mawr.

Bobbie was a member of the Merion Cricket Club for many years, where she played on the senior tennis league.

She was married to John Whiley Eckman; they divorced in 1975.

The family wishes to thank Nancy Shilcock and Gloria and George Maina, who provided extraordinary care for Barbara during the past 11 years.

A memorial service will be held at 1 p.m. on Saturday, October 18, at the chapel of Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church, 625 Montgomery Avenue, Bryn Mawr, Pa., 19010. The Reverend Agnes Norfleet will officiate.

Immediately following, all are invited to greet the family during a reception at the church.

A private interment service for the family will be held before the memorial service.
