Barbara Helen Crocker Williams died peacefully on October 7th, 2022, with family present. She was ninety-five. She was a resident of The Mansion at Rosemont in Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania.

Barbara, "Bobbie," was born to Derwood Raymond Crocker and Margaret Louise Weeks Crocker, on September 2nd, 1927, in Elmira, New York. She and her brother David lost their mother tragically when they were very young. Her father Derwood married Dorothy Benn Crocker, his second wife, when Barbara was eleven.
