Barbara Witherow Gardenhour, died on Friday Dec. 1, 2006,

daughter of William and Ruth Witherow. Born in Adams County and educated in the Gettysburg School District. Attended one year at Gettysburg College and graduated from Shippensburg University with a Bachelors of Education degree. Received a Masters of Education from Western Maryland, Westminster, MD.

Barbara began her teaching career in the Waynesboro School District and moved to Malvern, PA in 1962. Continued her teaching in Paoli at the Willistown Township School District (now part of the Great Valley School District). She entered the private sector in 1983 as Supervisor of Information for the Research Group of Johnson Matthey's North American office, headquartered in West Chester, PA. Subsequently she held various positions as Systems Librarian and Information Specialist in the Philadelphia and Harrisburg areas.
