



Barclay Allan Fleming

February 8, 1943 - May 22, 2025

Barclay Allan Fleming, 82, previously of 219 Williamsburg Road, Ardmore, PA, passed away peacefully at Arden Courts Memory Care in King of Prussia on Thursday May 22, 2025.

Born on February 8, 1943 in Philadelphia, PA, Barclay was the youngest son of George E. Fleming and Elizabeth A. Fleming (nee Harper).

Barclay was a graduate of Lower Merion High School and Villanova University, where he attended night school while working full time.

Barclay spent his career as an inside salesman for an electrical supply company, where he used his “radio voice” to great effect.

Barclay was a long-time parishioner at St. Mary’s Episcopal Church in Ardmore, PA, where he welcomed other parishioners as the head usher and rang the church bell at Sunday services. He was a devoted Philadelphia sports fan and a long-time season ticket holder for Villanova University football and basketball. Barclay also loved sailing on the Delaware Bay at Lewes Beach, DE, where his family has had a beachfront home for many years.

He is survived by his older brother Roger E. Fleming (Lynne) and six nephews and nieces – Jeffrey E. Fleming, Deborah L. Fleming, Timothy H. Fleming,

Richard A. Fleming Jr., Theodore W. Fleming and Timothy A. Fleming. He was predeceased by his brother Richard A. Fleming.

A funeral service will be held at St. Mary's Episcopal Church, 36 Ardmore Avenue, Ardmore, PA on Friday June 20, 2025 at 11 a.m.
