



## Beverley Wilson Spahr

February 21, 1938 - February 14, 2026

Beverley Wilson Spahr of Gladwyne, PA died on February 14th., 2026 at the age of 87.

Mrs. Spahr was born in Philadelphia in 1938 to Ruth Klink and Brigadier General George B. Wilson. She was a graduate of Dickinson College in Carlisle, PA and then taught English in Lower Merion Township for five years. She retired to raise her family and devoted her spare time to volunteer service.
