



## Carol Ann Sabik-Jaffe

Carol Ann Sabik-Jaffe, age 68, passed away peacefully on May 29, 2026 at home in Wynnewood, PA, surrounded by her family after a courageous battle with cancer.

Carol was born on March 23, 1958, to Bernard and Dorothy (DeSandes) Sabik in Elizabeth, NJ. The family relocated to Colts Neck, New Jersey where Carol spent her formative years.

She graduated from Kutztown University with a BFA in Communication Design, and Rosemont University with an MFA in Creative Writing. After a successful career as a Graphic Designer/Art Director, she segued into writing, placing first in multiple screenwriting competitions. Most recently, she self-published two contemporary rom-com novels. Carol taught screenwriting at the University of the Arts in Philadelphia, and screenwriting and writing for TV at Rowan University in New Jersey. She also served for ten years on the Board of Directors of the Philadelphia Writers' Conferences.

Carol loved spending time in her garden, growing gorgeous flowers admired by neighbors, and vegetables to experiment with in her kitchen. A Jersey Girl at heart, she also loved escaping to the Jersey Shore, sticking her toes in the sand, and listening to the sound of the ocean.

Above all else, Carol was deeply devoted to her family. She leaves behind her husband Dan, and their children Michael and Shaina. She is also survived by her sisters, Joan (David) Toner and Mary-Jo (Jeffrey) Kurtz, sisters in-law Rae Jaffe (Thomas Mullineaux) and Leah (the late Richard) Hight, as well as her many adored nieces and nephews.
