Charles Evans McGraw, age 77, of Radnor, PA, died on May 12, 2026, at Paoli Hospital after a brief illness.

Charles was born on November 20, 1948, in Pittsburgh, PA to Mary and Durban McGraw. He attended St. Edmunds Academy, Fay School, and Avon Old Farms School. He was a graduate of Emerson College, where he was on the Dean's List.
