



## Charlotte G. White

July 21, 1914 - October 28, 2013

Charlotte Gerhard White died of congestive heart failure at Waverly Heights, Gladwyne at the age of 99.

Mrs. White grew up in Overbrook on the Gerhard family compound, now owned by St. Josephs University. She graduated from the Master School at Dobbs Ferry on the Hudson and married Thomas Raeburn White, jr. in 1937. Mr. White, a well known trial lawyer and senior partner at White Williams Law Firm, died in 1990.

Charlotte White was a homemaker, an excellent bridge player, enthusiastic gardener, and enjoyed fishing and golf. She was an avid reader and loved doing needlework, cryptograms, and crossword puzzles.

Mrs. White was a member of the Acorn Club, Sunnybrook Golf Club, Four Counties Garden Club, and Pocono Lake Preserve, where she and her late husband spent summers. After he retired from the active practice of law, they traveled widely, often with groups from Penn's Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology, where Mr. White served as a Trustee for many years.

She is survived by her son, Thomas R. White, III, of Charlottesville, VA, and her daughter, Charlotte White Kalinna, of Ashland, OR. A son, Albert Gerhard White, pre-deceased her. She is also survived by seven grandchildren, and 12 great grandchildren.
