Christine Mackin Marshall, 42, passed away at her home in Haverford, PA on March 8, 2012 after a twenty-nine month battle with cancer. Born in Kingston, PA on April 8, 1969 and raised in Forty Fort, PA, “Bopper”, as she was known to her family, was the daughter of John and Mary Mackin. She graduated from Wyoming Valley West High School in 1987 and obtained her BS in Accounting from St. Joseph’s University in Philadelphia. 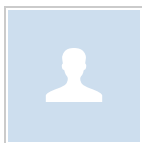
