



Constance Mettler Satterfield

July 14, 1933 - August 13, 2015

Constance Mettler Satterfield died peacefully on August 13th 2015. Mrs. Satterfield was born July 14th, 1932 in Circleville, Ohio to parents Melvin and Evelyn Mettler. She graduated from Ohio State University with a Marketing Degree and was a member of the Kappa Alpha Theta sorority. Mrs. Satterfield served on many committees, on the Board of Governors, and as a Vice President at the Merion Cricket Club in Haverford, Pennsylvania. She was a volunteer of the Historical Society of Pennsylvania, and an elected member of the National Genealogical Society, a member of the National Society of Colonial Dames XVII Century and as Chairman for the Red Cross Heart Campaign in 1966. She also traveled extensively throughout the United States and Europe researching the history of the textile trade.

Constance was a loving wife to her husband Jack F. Satterfield for 57 years until his death in 2004. She is survived by her four children, Jill S. Satterfield, John F. Satterfield and his wife Janis A. Satterfield and their children Carter Satterfield, Colby Satterfield, Andrew Adair and Meredith Adair, Bethanie S. Simon and her husband Bill and their children Will Simon, Blair Simon and Emily Simon, Kristen S. Levis and her husband Christian and children Christian Levis Jr. and Constance Levis. Mrs. Satterfield's twin brother Thomas Mettler passed in 2013 and she is survived by her sister Susan M. Allen and several beloved nieces and nephews.
