Craig Dunlap Culbert 82, of Merion Station, PA, passed away on Friday March 27, 2009 after a prolonged illness. He is survived by his wife, of 54 years, Mary Wilson Culbert. After graduating from Lower Merion High School in 1944 he went on to obtain his Bachelor's at Haverford College (1948) and Masters from Temple University (1952) and did not quite complete his PhD from Bryn Mawr College. While working on his Masters and PhD degrees, he taught part time at Haverford College and Temple University. He was offered a full time position at Beaver College, now Arcadia University, and remained there for 30 years as Assistant Professor of Organic Chemistry. He was devoted to his students often giving many hours to helping those who needed help. He received the Lindbach Award for outstanding teacher while at Beaver.

Craig was a skilled percussionist and performed for 25 years, mainly in timpani, with the Merion Concert Band.
