Cynthia Crowen Moses, 77, of Bryn Mawr, PA, a retired Volunteer Coordinator at Broomall Presbyterian Village, died in Bryn Mawr Hospital on Mon. Feb. 12, 2007.

Mrs. Moses was born in Evanston, Ill and later lived in Havana, Cuba and Montclair, NJ. She was a graduate of the now defunct Bradford Junior College, Haverhill, Mass., in 1950 and later earned a bachelor's degree from Villanova University.

After moving to the Philadelphia area in 1962 with her husband and two small children, she became an active volunteer with the Junior League of Philadelphia, the Main Line Branch of the American Red Cross and Teen-Aid/Big Sisters of Philadelphia. She served on the Junior League Board of Managers for a number of years as well as the Teen-Aid Board of Directors, becoming president from 1973 to 1975.

In 1976 she joined the staff at Broomall Presbyterian Village as Volunteer Services Coordinator, a position she held until retiring in 2002. She returned as a volunteer there and also volunteered at the Domestic Abuse Project of Delaware County. Her husband, the late Bill Moses, died in 2005. She is survived by daughter Melinda and son Philip, and three grandsons.

A memorial service will be held on Wed. Feb. 21, 12:30pm in the Chadwick & McKinney Funeral Home, 30 E. Athens Ave. Ardmore, where you may call

after 12 noon. Burial was private in the Washington Memorial Chapel Churchyard, Valley Forge National Park.
