Dennis R Hall, 1948 to 2025 died on Thursday September 11th, 2025 at the age 76 of Ardmore, PA.

Born in Philadelphia, Dennis was the son of Elias Hall and Anna Simpson Hall. Growing up in Philadelphia, he graduated from a Philadelphia trade school where he learned cabinetmaking. After moving to South Jersey, he joined the New Jersey Mill Cabinet Local Union 2098 and 252 where he built and installed exhibits for museums and trade shows across the country.

As a U.S. Army Veteran, he served during the Vietnam War and was stationed in Germany.

A cancer survivor, he moved to Florida after retirement, for almost 15 years. He became a dedicated Episcopalian and used his carpentry skills to enrich the church buildings and served on the Vestry of Shepherd of the Hills Church in Lecanto, FL and later St. Mark's Episcopal Church in Tampa, FL.

Dennis is survived by his wife, Karen Kennedy-Hall, of Ardmore; a daughter, Stephanie Elliott, (James) of Ardmore; and two grandchildren Nora (14) and Vivienne (9).

Dennis was the last sibling of predeceased brothers, James of Florida; Ronald

and Gerald of New Jersey.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, September 25 at 11 a.m. at St. George Episcopal Church, 1 Ardmore Avenue, Ardmore.
