Dottie also enjoyed going to the Gym at Curves. No doubt she enjoyed the socializing the most. She volunteered every 4th of July at the playground and with the Girl Scouts. She even sold Avon, bringing home the mini sample

lipsticks. She has always been a very outgoing person. Dorothy also loved going down the shore. Her parents had a beautiful Cottage in Stone Harbor/Avalon and later after retirement her and Bob enjoyed a good month or more, at the Tahiti Inn in Ocean City, N.J. The rest of the summer she spent at Belmont Hills pool with her friends. She enjoyed getting her hair done every Thursday by Fritz and catching Petie up on everything from the week. She worked on puzzles, putting them together like her Mother. She absolutely could not wait to become a Grandmother. She had fun playing games and cards with the kids, taking them across the street to the playground, going to all of their sporting events and watching tv shows with them. Their home, for over 60 years, was the Family gathering place for many Holidays, Birthdays and Celebrations. She was always the gracious host with a listening ear, a genuine smile, a big squeeze and a warm, caring heart, all the while she and her husband were vying over the kids attention.

Dorothy was an animal lover as well. She grew up with a black cat named Inky and over the years, opened her own home up to many cats, a few guinea pigs, an aquarium of fish, even a white mouse named Jake and a very special Beagle/Terrier mix Dog, named Sandy. Her most recent, Precious cat, whom was there for Bob and Dot, through both their illnesses, was their little girl, Lily. She was a Beautiful dilute Calico kitty with fur as soft as silk. Often they would argue over who's lap she would sleep on that evening. A year after Bob passed away and Dottie moved to Assisted Living at Haverford Estates/Brandywine in Bryn Mawr, she brought Lily with her.
