Dr. John Keyser Knorr III, a beloved Obstetrician, died on Tues. Nov. 13, 2007 at the age of 92.

Dr. Knorr was born on March 25th, 1915 in Philadelphia and spent his youth growing up in Wayne and graduating from Radnor High School. He went on to graduate from Dartmouth College and Jefferson Medical School, after which he went on to specialize in Obstetrics and Gynecology. He served in the US Navy in the second World War as a Navy doctor in the Phillipines.

He was on the staff of Pennsylvania Hospital and then Lankenau Hospital., where he started the Health Museum and will always be know for his wonderful personality and loving care.

Dr. Knorr was a long time member of Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church, where he served as Elder. He was also a member of Merion Cricket Club and Philadelphia Country Club, where he enjoyed his game of golf.

He is the beloved husband of Elizabeth Walker Knorr and devoted father of John K. Knorr, IV and Betsy Payne. He is also survived by two grandsons and two great granddaughters.

His Memorial Service will be held on Sat. Nov. 17, 11am in the Bryn Mawr

Presbyterian Church, 625 Montgomery Ave., Bryn Mawr PA.
