Dr. L. W. Irwin, 70 of Ardmore, PA, died on Sunday March 23, 2008 in the Bryn Mawr Hospital, He was born in Chanute, KS, and was the son of the late James Everett and Edna Irwin

Dr. Irwin was an Assistant Professor of English at Villanova University for over 41 years. He received his B.S. in 1959 from Baker University; M.A. in 1963 from the University of Kansas and his Ph.D. in English in 1969 from the University of Wisconsin. He also attended Medical School at the University of Kansas for two years.

He is survived by his brother, Sam Irwin and sister-in-law, Bertha Irwin of Augusta, KS; niece, Linda Merrill (Kirk) of Seattle, WA; nephew, Rex Irwin (Denise) of Wichita, KS; and great nieces, Kimberly, Samantha, and Jacquie
