He was raised in Stroudsburg PA and graduated from Lehigh University in 1948 with an engineering degree (with a brief detour to the Navy at the end of WW 2). While he was singing in the Lehigh glee club he met Phyllis Kline when his choir and the choir from Beaver (now Arcadia) combined for a concert. They married in 1950 and lived in Swarthmore from 1955. They were active members of the Swarthmore Presbyterian Church, singing in the choir and involved in just about any activity at the church.

Ed and Phyllis moved to White Horse Village in 2004. Phyllis passed away in 2021. Ed passed away shortly after his 99th birthday on April 3, 2026. He is survived by children Cliff (Joan Anderssen) Andy (Jane Knappe) and Cynthia (Ken Ulansey), grandchildren Adrienne, Brian (Ashley Hobart) and Ben and great-grandchildren Grant, Harrison and Theodore Edward.
