



## Edwin J. Foltz

December 31, 1915 - September 24, 2009

Edwin J. Foltz, 93, former president of Campbell Soup International, died September 24 at Waverly Heights after a 10-month illness.

Prior to his 28-year career at Campbell Soup Company, Mr. Foltz served as special agent for the FBI under J. Edgar Hoover and director of industrial public relations for Borg-Warner Corporation in Cleveland. A graduate of Washington and Lee University and its law school, Mr. Foltz completed his career at Hepburn Wilcox Hamilton and Putnam in Philadelphia.

Mr. Foltz was also active in community affairs, serving as president of the Philadelphia Crime Commission, a trustee of the Gladwyne Free Library, vice chairman of the World Affairs Council of Philadelphia, and president of the board of directors at Washington and Lee University Alumni Association.

He was a member of the Philadelphia Union League, the Merion Cricket Club, and the vestry of St. Christopher's Episcopal Church.

He is survived by his wife, Barbara; his son, Jeff; his daughter, Dorothy Foltz-Gray; his step-children David, Anne, Susan, and Mary Eisenhower; plus numerous grandchildren and great grand-children. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Deane Mitchell Foltz and his daughter, Deane.

His funeral service and reception will be held on Monday Sept. 28, 11:30am in St. Christopher's Episcopal Church, 226 Righters Mill Road, Gladwyne. PA 19035. A private interment in the Churchyard will follow the service.
