



Elizabeth Rudisill Beadle

December 4, 1929 - August 17, 2008

Elizabeth Rudisill Beadle died peacefully at home in Wynnewood, on August 15, 2008, at age 78. She was born December 4, 1929, to George and Elizabeth Rudisill, in York, Pa., and attended York High School. She was graduated from Chatham University in Pittsburgh with a degree in sociology, and later attended Temple University. She held various positions as clerk, dental assistant, and receptionist, including ten years at Community Health Affiliates in Ardmore, and since 2000, at the Havertown Center for Older Adults.

She and Theodore A. Beadle, from Radnor, were married on November 11, 1952, and moved to Orleans, France, until 1954. After several years in Pittsburgh, and then in Ohio, they settled in Wynnewood. Elizabeth was an avid reader, loved being at the shore, and swam almost daily. She enjoyed traveling to West Virginia, Colorado, and Oregon to visit her daughters and their families.

She is survived by Theodore Beadle, children Susan, Timothy, and Michele, and grandchildren Sky, Benjamin, and Alexandra. She is also survived by brothers James and Abram Rudisill.
