Emma "Brownie" Brownback Dunlop of Bryn Mawr, PA, died peacefully at Waverly Heights on February 22, 2008 at the age of 93 ½. She was preceded in death by her beloved husband, Robert G. Dunlop, former Chairman of the Board of the Sun Oil Company. Born September 11, 1914, the daughter of Mary Detweiler and Harry Brownback, she grew up on a dairy farm in the rolling hills of Chester County.
