Evelyn Day of Hobe Sound, FL and Villanova, PA died on June 3rd surrounded by her loving family from complications following a hemorrhagic stroke. She is survived by her husband of 53 years, Rodney Day, daughters Evelyn Day Lasry, Allison Day Norley and Hilary Day Maner, eight grandchildren, her siblings Marion Ballard and Jay Scattergood. She was 75 years old.

Mrs. Day grew up in Villanova and graduated from The Shipley School and Vassar College. She and her husband started their married life in New York City, returned to Philadelphia, moved on to Charlotte, NC, then back to Philadelphia and New York City. She was active in many volunteer capacities with the Episcopal Church, the Nature Conservancy, The Junior League, The Shipley School, and the Garden Club of America. Currently, she had just begun a term as President of The Hobe Sound Nature Center in Florida. Improving education and protecting the environment were the main drivers of her community service.

For more than 40 years, she was a passionate bird watcher, traveling the North American Continent from Attu in the far northwest, to Baffin Island north

of the Arctic Circle, to the Dry Tortugas south of Florida, to the Sierra Madre mountain range in the southwest. She had nearly 700 species on her life list, all carefully recorded. More importantly, she made many friends, once saying she had never met a birder she didn't like.

A celebration of her life will take place at The Church of the Redeemer in Bryn Mawr on June 9 at 11am. Burial will be private.
