Everett J. McConaghy Jr., “Jack” of Springfield, PA passed away peacefully on November 14, 2023. He was born on October 19, 1946, in Philadelphia, PA. He was the son of the late Everett J. and Shirley (Riley) McConaghy and brother to Diane Stanton.

After high school, Jack enlisted in the Marine Corps. He was proud to serve and never let his kids forget the Marine Corps Birthday (10 November).
