Frank Hemphill, a 40 year resident of Marple Township, died on Friday Oct. 14th, 2011 at age 80. He was born in Philadelphia and was the son of the late Edith and William Hemphill. A graduate of the Class of 1949 of Haverford High School, Frank was a retired florist for more than 35 years, and the owner of Brill's Flowers in Ardmore and Broomall. In addition, he was a partner in Goodhill Associates, for more than 40 years, a local real estate investment company. In 1963, Frank and several other florists started Cash Inc/Floralink, a cooperative buying group which continued for many years, with a warehouse in New Jersey. Frank was also a founder of Rush Delivery Service in 1980, a cooperative delivery company consisting of 50 retail flower shops. A Member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church in Broomall, PA, a caring and devoted husband, father, and grandfather, he enjoyed many happy moments and memories with so many friends and family, and has always been so thankful for all of his blessings. He is survived by his wife of 40 years, Mary June (nee Kemel); daughter, Meredith June Tuohey of Havertown; son, Franklin Gregory Hemphill of Broomall; granddaughters Caila June and Lily Magnolia Tuohey of Havertown; and brothers, William of Lancaster and Robert of Media.
