



Garret Stephen Voorhees II

November 6, 1934 - April 28, 2024

Garret Stephen Voorhees, II died peacefully on Sunday, April 28, 2024. He was 89.

Steve was born in Buffalo, NY on November 6, 1934 to Garret Coerte Voorhees and Lois Gaw Voorhees. He spent his formative years in Middletown, DE where his father was a teacher, crew coach and advisor at St. Andrews School. He attended Kent School in Kent, CT and went on to graduate from the University of Delaware with a bachelor's degree in history.

After serving two years in the U.S. Army (SP4), Steve began what would be a life-long career in the insurance business. He always loved music and song, and in 1969 he joined Philadelphia's Orpheus Club, where he was a member for over 40 years.

He was a member of the Church Foundation for the Diocese of Pennsylvania.

Steve is survived by his daughters, Tracey Crawford Voorhees Freeman and Dana Beekman Voorhees, and his son-in-law, Samuel T. Freeman, III. His wife, Mary Ann Voorhees, preceded him in death on June 27, 2006.

Funeral services will be held on Wednesday May 8th at 11am at St. Christopher's Episcopal Church, Gladwyne, PA. Interment will take place in

the Churchyard, followed by a reception.
