Gladys Reynolds Monier (nee Baker), age 98, on March 11, 2013, wife of the late Alexander H Reynolds Jr and subsequently the late Harold L Monier.

Survived by 3 children: Karen Hires, Ross Reynolds (Janey), Hugh Reynolds (Susan); 3 stepchildren: Michael Monier (Carolyn), David Monier (Debbie}, Joe Monier (Phyllis); 23 grandchildren and 32 great-grandchildren who cherished her wisdom, wit and love. Gladys delighted in needlepointing over 45 individualized Christmas stockings for her ever-expanding family .

Gladys grew up in Cynwyd, daughter of the late Gladys and Frank Baker, oldest of 3 sisters: Nan Wertman and the late Jean Anthony. She attended Cynwyd Elementary, Friends Central and Sarah Lawrence through which she spent a year in Switzerland.

Family came first but Gladys also taught Sunday school at the Bala Cynwyd Methodist Church, worked closely with the team planning for Harriton High School and volunteered for the Red Cross, various home and school associations, and Inglis House where she developed close relationships with several of the residents, even corresponding with them while on vacation.

Gladys and Lex moved to Florida when he retired and she continued her expert bridge playing, gardening and volunteering for the local hospice. After Lex's death, she married Harold Monier acquiring his caring and supportive family.

Gladys loved her summers in Maine as the excellent Admiral of her family.

She was the first woman president of the Sheepscot Island Company, a supporter of the Maine Maritime Museum and a gracious host to family and friends who enjoyed sharing her island life.
