Gordon “Gordie” Evan Wright, age 88, of Berwyn, PA went home to be with his Lord on January 13, 2023.

Gordon, the beloved son of the late C. Elmer and Ruth (Edwards) Wright, Maywood N.J. Gordon was born in Passaic, N.J on January 9, 1935. He graduated in 1952 from Bogota High School, Bogota, N.J. Gordon received his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree from Lafayette College in 1956 in Easton, PA. He honorably served in the U.S. Army and retired as Captain. He was stationed in Fort Benning, GA and Fort Jackson, SC. During his career, Gordon was proud to have worked at Bell Telephone of PA, W.H. Newbold’s Brokerage Firm Compliance Officer of Philadelphia, and Nationwide of King of Prussia and retired as Chief Compliance Officer.

Gordie (PopPop, Popsie, PopTart) was the patriarch, “Captain” of our close family of twenty-one. He was our leader- selfless, supportive, brave, kind, and a mentor and loved unconditionally with his whole heart.
