Harlon Humphreys Morse, 23, of Ardmore, PA, died tragically as the result of a motorcycle accident on Thurs. July 10, 2008.

Harlon was born in Austin, TX, and raised on the Main Line, graduating from Delaware Valley Friends School. He was employed by Chanticleer as a seasonal groundskeeper for the last four years.

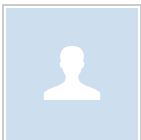
