



## Harriet DeMott Betner

June 13, 1917 - July 11, 2008

Harriet DeMott Betner of Haverford died Friday, July 11, 2008 surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Tenafly, New Jersey on June 13, 1917, the daughter of Richard Hopper DeMott and Hazel Childs DeMott.

Mrs. Betner graduated from the Dwight School in Englewood, New Jersey and Finch College in New York City. She was an active member of the Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church.

Descended from Richard Warren of Headborough, England, Mrs. Betner was a life time member of The Pennsylvania Society of Mayflower Descendants, where she served as past treasurer for a number of years and a member-at-large of the Board in 2004.
