



Heath M. Kennedy

February 17, 1948 - October 29, 2012

Heath Mirick Kennedy of Haverford, PA died October 29th, 2012. She was the wife of Mark Kennedy and mother of Devon (Nickel), Christopher, Ashley and Tyson. She had five grandchildren, Madison, Conor and Hayden Nickel and Lorelei and Ellianna Kennedy. Her father was Henry Mirick, head of Mirick, Pearson & Batchelor architects and her mother was Marion Winsor Mirck. She was born at Hedgeley, her family estate in Wynnewood where she resided most of her life.

She shared her family's love of animals. When she was young her family had a donkey, monkey, sheep, Humphrey Heath's Newfoundland dog, parrots, and her favorite Siamese cats. Heath studied animal behavior at Barro Colorado Island in Panama and later volunteered at the Philadelphia Zoo working in the cages with the Zoo's baby gorillas and a withdrawn chimpanzee that she socialized. She obtained a master's degree at Temple in Special Education and was one of the first teachers at Woodhaven Institute working with special needs children and adults.

She married in 1975 and became a homemaker. Later she helped her husband manage their businesses which included two companies ranked in the Philly 100 most rapidly growing companies.

She travelled extensively including two safaris in Africa and summers in Europe and the West.

She was a gentle woman who was devoted to her husband and their children. During her 2+ years living with and eventually dying from cancer; she faced

her most difficult moments with a loving smile and a gentle concern for her family rather than for herself.
