Longtime GE employee - Havertown Resident, died on March 23, 2009

Born in Indiana, son of the late Benjamin and Bess Pogue. Upon graduating from Purdue University with a B.S. in Electrical Engineering, was employed by General Electric Co. After the one year training program and permanently employed was sent to the Bureau of Ships, Navy Department in Washington, D.C. during WW2, where he met and married his wife, Josephine, who was a WAVE in the Navy and stationed in the Bureau of Ships. They were married by Dr. Peter Marshall, minister of the Presbyterian Church at Washington, D.C. and also presided at Congressional meetings. They celebrated 64 years of marriage on January 28, 2009.

At the end of WW2 they returned to General Electric at Schenectady, NY until 1955 when his department transferred to Roanoke, VA. In 1957 he transferred to Philadelphia Control Division at 69th Street until his retirement in 1980. He was Past President of GE Quarter Century Club, and GE Retirees Club, lifetime member of St. Georges F. A.M. After retirement he volunteered with Red Cross as CPR and First Aid Instructor. He was a long time member of First Presbyterian Church of Ardmore, and served as Past Trustee, Past Pres. Of Married Couples Group and Usher from 1963 until a stroke in 2004 ended his service.

He was Past Chairman of Boy Scout Troop 156, received Chapel of Four Chaplains award for his many years of local community service.

Survivors: Wife, Josephine, sons Ronald E.residing at Royersford, and Jeffrey B.residing at State College, daughter Arleen deceased in 2004, five grandchildren, Amanda Walmsley, Steve, Jamie, Tom and Jason, three great-grandchildren, Anna, Samantha and Teddy.Walmsley.
