JACK CRAIG McKINNEY, 55, a longtime resident of Middletown, PA, died peacefully at home surrounded by family and friends on Wed. January 19, 2011 after a two year battle with lung cancer. He is the son of Jeanne E.(nee Rice) and the late Jackson Wallis McKinney.
