



## James Joseph Procacci

October 4, 1944 - October 15, 2024

Our beloved James Joseph Procacci, affectionately known as "Jimmie", departed from this world on October 15th 2024 at 80 years of age. James was born on October 4th 1944 in Camden NJ to Rita Belmonte and Michael Procacci. He graduated from Collingswood High School in 1962 and went on to join the U.S. Army on July 31st 1963. He served as a medic in Korea, and was the recipient of the National Defense Service Medal during this time. On July 28th 1966 James was honorably discharged from the Army and returned to NJ. He met his wife Mary Gallagher while working at RCA in Camden, NJ and they married on February 9th 1974. James and Mary then resided in Collingswood NJ, where he began his career in the automobile industry at Rohrer Chevrolet and started a family. In 1986, James moved to Ardmore PA, where he lived for 38 years while raising a family with his wife Mary Gallagher Procacci and working as a Sales Manager at Motorsport Nissan, West Chester Jeep and Thomas Chevrolet, where he received regional recognition as a leader in sales and customer service. James enjoyed sharing meals with his family and friends, (especially Italian food), playing tennis and chess, watching sports (Go Eagles & Phillies), and photography, a field in which he received an award from Nikon in 1977. He will be remembered for how he cherished his family and friends with his loving, gentle and kind spirit; how he made them laugh with his incredible sense of humor, and most of all, his big beautiful smile which would light up the room. James passed away at Bryn Mawr Hospital surrounded by family after several years of declining health.

James is survived by his wife, Mary Frances Gallagher Procacci, his daughters Jennifer Lynn Procacci and Christina Jamie Procacci, and his sisters, Nancy Boody and Antionette Bonney.

Services will be held on October 26th 2024 at St. Mary's Church 426 Monmouth Street, Gloucester City New Jersey with visitation beginning at 10am, followed by a celebration of life Mass at 11am. From 12:30-2:30pm, the family will host a luncheon at Max's Seafood Cafe, 34 N Burlington St Gloucester City New Jersey. From 4-6pm, the family will receive guests at their home.
