Janet Morrison Tyre, 89, 10-year resident of The Quadrangle in Haverford, PA, formerly of Westfield, NJ, on March 11; wife of the late David N. Tyre ; survived by sons Steven and his wife Lynn of Newtown Square, PA and Philip of Dunedin, FL, three grandchildren, Sarah, James, and Douglas Tyre, great-granddaughter Elizabeth Grace Tyre, and sister Eileen Moyer of Branson, Mo. Janet emigrated from Scotland to Philadelphia in 1923, grew up in North Philadelphia on Ontario Street, moved to Cheltenham and graduated from Cheltenham High School in 1937 and Beaver College in 1941; after teaching high school French and Latin she served during WWII in one of the first classes of the US Navy Wave Corps in the intelligence department at the Philadelphia Navy Yard; while raising her family Janet resided in Elkins Park, Cranford and Westfield, NJ, Caracas, Venezuela, Houston, TX, and Brussels, Belgium; as a lifelong pianist, choral singer, lover of classical music and advocate for music education Janet's wish is that in lieu of flowers contributions in her honor be made to the West Philadelphia Children's Choir c/o Bryn Mawr Presbyterian Church, 625 Montgomery Ave., Bryn Mawr, PA 19010.
