Jennie grew up in Montrose and attended the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing receiving her RN in 1946. She raised five children while assisting Bud in his veterinary practice. Later, she worked for years as a nurse at Montrose General Hospital. Jennie belonged to the Gradale Club, Junior Women's Club and Monday Evening Club. Passionate about community service, she was a member of The Red Cross Board of Directors, a member of the Montrose Borough Planning Commission and served on the Vestry of St. Paul's Episcopal Church. Legacy Lady in 2011. She was a caring, committed and thoughtful citizen who shared her time and talent. Jennie was curious, non judgmental and receptive to new ideas. After retiring, Jennie began art lessons. She joined Hill Country Artists and became an accomplished painter. She traveled extensively throughout Europe and visited South Africa and Madagascar. Jennie celebrated her 91st birthday in Tokyo, Japan.

Jennie was predeceased by her son, Stephen A. Bowen. She is survived by
