John P. Gregg of Bryn Mawr, PA died on June 1, 2017 at the age of 70, a resident of Beaumont at Bryn Mawr since 2011. He was survived by his brother and sister-in-law, William P. and Julie Gregg, of Harpers Ferry, West Virginia, three nieces and a nephew as well as his dear friend, the Reverend David R. Adam, several cousins and countless people who were fortunate to call him “friend”.

John was a proud graduate of Episcopal Academy (1965), Trinity College (1969) and Villanova Law School (1974). After admission to the Pennsylvania Bar in 1974, John was appointed Law Clerk to Judge John R. Henry of the Court of Common Pleas of Montgomery County. John soon joined the law firm of High Swartz Roberts and Seidel in Norristown, where his grandfather had been a founding partner. John practiced in the areas of domestic relations and criminal law and was an Assistant Public Defender with Montgomery County throughout his career.

Over the years John served on the boards of numerous civic, charitable, legal and business organizations and received various related honors and awards. He was a member of The Merion Cricket Club where he engaged in regular competitive but always congenial tennis matches.

One of a kind, John brightened the day of everyone he met with his wonderful humor and unique outlook on life. He will be sorely missed.

His Memorial Service will be held on Wed. June 7th. at 1 PM in Church of the Redeemer, 230 Pennswood Rd., Bryn Mawr, PA 19010. Burial will be private in the Churchyard.
