John C. Foster, 76, died on Wednesday, January 30, 2013. Born in Bryn Mawr, a long time resident of Wayne, and more recently of Gulph Mills, John was the son of the late John H. and Marjorie L. Foster. He is survived by his daughter Wendy Foster, sisters Dr. Sylvia and Beverly Foster, stepsons Robert and John Bartenstein, nieces, a nephew, and step-grandchildren. His sister Diana Foster preceded him in death in 1997. John was a graduate of both Radnor High School (1954) and Friends' Central School (1955), where he did one year as a post graduate. After earning a B.A. from Wesleyan University in 1959 and an M.B.A. from Harvard Business School in 1965, John worked for many years at Diamond Glass Company in Royersford, PA, rising to the positions of Vice President and Corporate Director. He left Diamond Glass to found Foster Glass, a glass manufacturer in Salem, NJ. Subsequently, he started Foster Credit Company, which he headed until his retirement. He enjoyed playing squash, tennis and bridge, reading, watching films, traveling, fine dining, and vacationing in Longport, NJ. He was a member of the Free & Accepted Masons, Spring City Lodge and The Alpha Delta Phi fraternity.
