Judith Powell Orr, 82, of Haverford, PA, died on March 31, 2023.

Judy was born to Jane Carr Dahl Powell and Russell William Powell on August 11, 1940, in Bronxville, NY. She was the granddaughter of Florence and George V. Dahl of Chicago, Illinois.

She graduated from Bronxville High School, and Centenary College, in Hackettstown, NJ. As a young woman, Judy worked at Young & Rubicam in advertising in New York City. She also dabbled in the modeling industry, with her most notable assignment at Virginia Slims.

She was a loving mother to four children, Peter Braun, Christy Kohler, Nancy Orr, and William Orr III, raising her family in Berwyn, PA, and then later moving to Haverford, PA.

Judy is survived by her children, Peter Braun of Colorado, Christy Kohler of New Jersey and Charleston, S.C., Nancy Orr of Colorado and Montana, and pre-deceased by her loving son "Billy" in 1995. She is also survived by her grandchildren, Shae, Markus, and Leah Braun, and Max Kohler as well as her two sisters, Barbara Parsons and Nancy Schoenwald. She is also survived by her longtime companion Bill Menna of Haverford, and their four cats, Bode, Sweet Pea, Chelsea, and Itty Bitty.

Judy was known to family and friends as “Jude.” She was a huge lover of animals and an ardent fan of music. She was a member of Our Mother of Good Counsel Parish in Bryn Mawr.

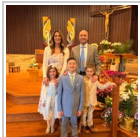

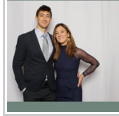

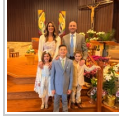
