



## Laurence Stacey Brown

February 10, 1940 - January 21, 2016

Laurence Stacey Brown died peacefully on January 21, 2016 surrounded by family.

Larry grew up in Oklahoma City and moved to the Philadelphia area in 1967. He graduated from the Casady School in 1958 and went on to study at Harvard and the University of Kansas. He then received his Master's degree at Stanford in East Asian Studies; as a part of his course of study he spent a year living in Japan.

Larry spent his professional life in the steel importing business, at Kurt Orban, Toyota, and his own firm, LSB Steel, primarily focusing on trade with Asia. He was an avid sports fan, a gifted athlete, and a long-time member of the Wynnewood Lanes Bowling League. He loved animals and the outdoors. Larry was a 36-year member of Alcoholics Anonymous, a community from which he received great strength and support and to which he gave much in return.

Larry will be remembered as a kind and loving husband, brother, father, grandfather, and friend.

He was pre-deceased by his wife Elizabeth and his brother Harvey. He is survived by his sister Marian MacFarlane of Colorado; daughter, Melissa Brown; son, Fraser; son-in-law, Alexander Arzoumanian; daughter-in-law, Catharine; grandsons, Robert Arzoumanian, Samuel Brown, and Fraser C. Brown; and stepson, David Byerley (Margaret) and his family; nieces, nephews, and extended family.
