On January 9, 2008 at age 101 after a short illness. Born Lelia Evelyn Humpton in 1906, she was a long time resident of Ardmore and was known and loved by many as "Humpty", a childhood nickname which stayed with her.

She graduated from Lower Merion High School and went on to West Chester Normal School, now West Chester University, studying physical education. After teaching Phys Ed for a period of time, she moved into business.

She spent many summers in the financial office of Camp Bueno in New Hampshire. There she could swim, play tennis and bike as well as work. These were the sports she loved and continued them regularly well into her 80's. She also worked for many years as a bookkeeper at Bryn Mawr College as well as for several private companies.

Humpty was an active, near life long member of the First Baptist Church of Ardmore where she sang in the choir, assisted in church activities and was the Financial Secretary for many years.

In 1963 she married Frank C. Harmstad. They resided in Ardmore for a short period of time before moving to Gulf Mills, PA. They enjoyed traveling around

the country visiting friends and family along the way. After Frank's death in the early 70's, she moved to Rosemont Presbyterian Village where she resided until 2005 when she moved to the Residence at Glen Riddle in Media, PA.

She is survived by niece Gaye Humpton of California and step-daughter Dorothy Harmstad Wolff of Berwyn. She also has many step grandchildren and great grand children, nieces and nephews. She will be missed by all who knew and loved her.
