Margaret E. Lentz (nee Allbright) died peacefully at the Brommall Presbyterian Village on Thursday, February 20, 2014, at the age of 94. Born and raised in Lebanon, Pennsylvania, she was the daughter of Paul and Clara Allbright.

Encouraged by her Sunday School teacher to pursue a nursing career, she graduated from the Bryn Mawr Nursing School and attended the University of Pennsylvania School of Nursing. During her career, she served as the Assistant Director of Nurses at the Bryn Mawr Hospital and also as the summer nurse at the Flanders Hotel in Ocean City, New Jersey.

Margaret enjoyed many activities, most especially reading her Bible and sharing the Gospel. She was totally devoted to her Lord and to her family, and was a long-time member of the Narberth Presbyterian Church.
