### OBITUARY FOR MARGARET NUTT

Margaret Anne Morris Nutt, age 90 years, died peacefully on January 14, 2014 at the Quadrangle Retirement Community in Haverford, PA. She was married to James Norwell Nutt, Jr. for sixty years until he passed away in 2011. She and Jim had lived at the Quadrangle since 1992, and were active for many years as new resident greeters and volunteers on many resident committees.

Mrs. Nutt (Migs, as she was known to friends and family) was born in Troy, NY in 1923 to Robert Morris Jr. and Anna Marie Ruoff Morris. Her sister Charlotte Morris Stebbins died in Troy in 2000. Mrs. Nutt graduated from the Emma Willard School in 1941 and attended Russell Sage College. She met her husband, a student at Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in Troy, and they were married in Massapequa, NY in 1943. During World War II, the family resided at the U.S. Navy Picatinny Arsenal Munitions Depot at Lake Denmark, NJ. After the war they moved to Mountain Lakes, NJ, and finally to Wallingford, PA where they lived for forty years. Migs was an active mother and community volunteer with many school groups, the Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts, and Lankenau Hospital. She was a member of the Village Gardeners Garden Club of Wallingford, The Modern Club of Philadelphia, and a docent at the Winterthur Museum.

She was predeceased by her husband and her daughter, Linda Nutt Northrop (Richard Rockwell Stafford Northrop) of Greenwich CT. She is survived by her son James Norwell Nutt III, MD (Elizabeth Cresson Nutt) of Blue Bell, PA, and by her daughter Nancy Nutt Schiffer (Peter Berwind Schiffer, dec.) of West Chester, PA. Eight grandchildren also survive her: James Norwell Nutt IV, VMD, Robert Cresson Nutt, MD, David Lukens Nutt, DPT, Herbert Nutt Schiffer, DO, Peter Nutt Schiffer, Heather Daniell Northrop, Virginia Morris Northrop, Kent Johnston Northrop; and three great grandsons, Wilson Peter Schiffer, Porter James Schiffer and Graham Morris Nutt.

She was proud of and devoted to her family. They will always cherish her wonderful examples of humility and patience. A private memorial service and burial will be held at Trinity Episcopal Church, Swarthmore, PA on January 25, 2014.
