



## Margaret B. Vandermade

November 4, 1919 - December 25, 2010

Margaret Vandermade (nee Brush) of Waverly Heights, Gladwyne, PA, died on Dec. 25, 2010.

She was born in Brookline, MA, on November 4, 1919. She graduated from Winsor School, Boston, MA, Class of 1938 and Bennington College, Bennington, VT, Class of 1942. Upon graduation from College she worked for Harvard School of Public Health in research from 1942-1946. In November of 1947 she married James S. Vandermade.

Before moving to Waverly Heights in 1994, she was a longtime resident of Montclair, NJ from 1955-1994. Mrs. Vandermade was very active in the community, where she volunteered at Montclair Historical Society, The Montclair Museum of Art, Mountainside Hospital, and the First Congregational Church. After moving to Waverly Heights she served on the decorating committee, and was a contributor to the resident publication, The Waverly Window; and was a member of St. Christopher's Episcopal Church.

She was the wife of the late James S. Vandermade; and is survived by her children James S. Vandermade, Jr.(Julia), Lisa R. Vandermade(Robert Popick); grandchildren: Hobart(Jennifer), Anna and Adam Popick; great grandchildren: Kate and Ethan Popick; and brother: William Brush(Harriet).
